TEMPORARY RELOCATION OF THE REGISTRY OF MARRIAGES AND REGISTRY OF MUSLIM MARRIAGES TO MND BUILDING

The Registry of Marriages (ROM) and Registry of Muslim Marriages (ROMM) will be operating at a **temporary office at the Ministry of National Development (MND) Building on Maxwell Road from 26 January 2010 to February 2011**, while the existing building at Canning Rise undergoes renovation.

2 To allow for the office equipment, furniture and documents to be moved to the temporary premises, ROM and ROMM will be **closed from Saturday 23 to Monday 25 January 2010**. During this period, members of the public can continue to call the ROM and ROMM main lines for assistance and enquiries.

3 **The ROM and ROMM will resume all services at the temporary premises from 26 January 2010**. The location address and contact numbers are as follows:

4 The upcoming renovation of the existing ROM Building at Canning Rise is the first major upgrading work since its opening in 1983. The public can look forward to a modern building with improved accessibility, more spacious waiting and public service areas and a more conducive environment that blends in with the surrounding park.

5 To provide better access to all services including marriage registration, solemnisation and information services, the interior space of the ROM Building will be reconfigured to move all public services to the ground floor. An open concept design has been adopted to allow more natural light into the building and integration with the surrounding Fort Canning Park. The external grounds of ROM Building will also be landscaped to improve overall ambience. The renovation is expected to be completed in January 2011.

6 Members of the public who drive can park at the public carpark at MND Complex. Bus Services available are: 57, 131, 167, 186, 700, 970 (Cecil Street). The nearest MRT Station is Tanjong Pagar MRT.
